Silver Economy Expo's second year The tradeshow for the seniors' sector 4th and 5th December 2014, Porte de Versailles, Paris

With 15 million people over the age of 60 and the population of over-75s due to double by 2050¹, the future is bright for the seniors' industry, which was given a formal launch just over a year ago. To help support the sector, Silver Economy Expo, the B to B 'Technology and services for seniors' tradeshow, will be held for its second year at the Porte de Versailles on the 4th and 5th December this year.

'By holding the Silver Economy Expo and working together with the most of the organizations which have a role in the seniors' sector, we aim to hold an event which will boost the sector and help to develop a wide range of first class competitive services and products' explains Alain Bosetti , manager and organizer of the show.

The seniors' industry: important both for our economy and for our society

Seniors are expected to account for 54 % of consumer expenditure by 2015² and products and services must match their expectations and cater for their varied lifestyles: employed and retired seniors, seniors who are frail or in need of support, healthy seniors etc.

Health, services, housing, home automation, telecommunications, food, facilities, leisure, tourism, transport... every sector is affected!

The industry could therefore create 300 000 jobs by 2020³.

Silver Economy Expo: a tradeshow supporting the organizations in the industry

Silver Economy Expo promotes discussion and idea-sharing amongst the organizations in its ecosystem. The 2-day programme includes: a seminar on the key issues affecting the sector, approximately 20 conferences and 80 exhibitors
