Silver Economy Expo

9th year for the Show on 23rd and 24th November 2021: in Paris, Porte de Versailles and also on the internet

« Innovation and cooperation: changing the lives of seniors and their helpers ».

Seniors are currently the focus of attention, support... and debate in a way that they have rarely been in the past.

Our **ageing population**¹ and **the worsening of the demographic ratio of dependence** has required for a long period of time a better coordination of initiatives to help seniors and to mobilise new resources to promote good management of ageing and to encourage innovation in all its forms (technological, social, organisational etc).

The following have focused attention on seniors and their helpers, **all occurring five months away from the presidential election**: the "Strategy for autonomy" plan in the <u>2022 PLFSS</u> (2022 Finances for Social Security Bill) following the fresh abandonment of the "Autonomy in old age" bill , the application of amendment 43, the 2022 initiative called Ma Santé ("my health"), <u>the provision of prescriptions for ergotherapists</u>, instant tax credits, the impact of compulsory vaccination in professions under strain.

Silver Economy Expo will be a key event at the end of the year.

Silver Economy Expo is a show for professionals which began in 2013 following the creation of the silver economy sector by ministers Michèle Delaunay and Arnaud Montebourg. It focuses on services and technology for seniors (whether they are in good health, fragile or dependant) and their helpers. This year it will take place in a hybrid form, Porte de Versailles and on the internet on the 23rd and 24th November. Those involved in the sector will display their innovations, talk about the results of trials of their solutions and how effective they have been in all the types of organisations which have seniors and helpers as their clients, residents or end-users. The show also includes some support and advice for setting up businesses, financing and developing them.

"The exponential increase in the number of people aged 100 in France is a symbolic marker of the ageing of the population and longevity. It also shows us how urgently we must come up with and decide upon immediate and concrete solutions and put them into effect with a long-term vision which will promote a better quality of life for the ageing. This will happen by new collaborations between people involved in helping the elderly, integrating innovations and of course new funding" says Alain Bosetti, President of Silver Economy Expo.
